## All items below must be present for the duration of the placement.

- The service is a regulated children's education and care service in Australia
- Access to children aged 5-12 years from a range of different cultural backgrounds including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples
- All relevant policies, procedures, and workplace documentation to carry out their tasks including:
- WHS and emergency response procedures including maintaining a safe learning environment for school age children in outside school hours care such as:
  - Mandatory reporting
  - o Infection control procedures
  - Reporting procedures
  - o Risk assessment
  - o Complaints policies and procedures
  - Food handling, storage and preparation procedures
  - o Managing medical conditions procedures
  - o Exclusion procedures
  - o Transporting children (as applicable) to and from the service
  - o Excursions and outings outside of the service
  - Orientation procedures
  - o Incident, injury, accident and trauma procedures
  - Sleep and rest procedures
  - o Sun protection procedures
  - o First aid procedures
  - o Procedures for communicating with families, guardians, carers
  - o Procedures for communicating with regulatory bodies and regulators
  - Procedures for developing learning programs for school age children ranging in age from 5 - 12 years
- Personal protective equipment appropriate to the role and work area such as gloves, aprons, hairnets, sunhats, sunscreen, sunglasses
- Workplace technology for the purposes of recording observations and facilitating live feeds with an ACTAC assessor
- Workplace resources, for supporting individual learning and needs of children, and families
- Access to a diploma or higher qualified educator at the service to supervise placement
- Access to documents related to the learning framework and resources for supporting education and care, such as My Time Our Place, session and program plans
- Technology such as computers, laptops, ipads televisions and gaming devices (as applicable)
- Books and other reading material
- Workplace resources, for supporting individual leisure, learning and care needs of children, and families:
- Indoor play equipment
- Outdoor play equipment
- Sporting equipment

- materials from the natural environment
